After graduating from the University of Connecticut, USA with a Ph.D in Sports Management, he was appointed as a lecturer with the Faculty of Educational Studies, Universiti Putra Malaysia in 1999. Dr Aminuddin was promoted to Associate Professor in 2003. He was appointed as the Head of the Sports Industry Laboratory at UPM's Sports Academy from 2003-2006 and as the director of the Sports Academy from 2006-2009, Dr. Aminuddin is currently the Head of the Dept of Sport Studies, Faculty of Educational Studies, a position he also served from 2010-2012. In 2013 Dr. Aminuddin was promoted to full professor. Prof Aminuddin has been actively involved in research and professional services in the areas of Sports Management, Sports Industry and Sports Tourism. In addition to his publications in national and international sports science and physical education journals and others, he has made invited and keynote presentations at various professional meetings such as the Malaysian Association for Physical Education, Sports Science and Fitness (PPJSKM), International Council for Health Physical Education, Recreation and Dance (ICHPER), ASEAN Conference on Physical Education &amp; Sports Science (ACPES) and Korean Sports Industry conferences.
