She is also involved in research on counseling supervision and post-traumatic stress disorder among flood victims. She has been consistently research on practice of Islamic psycho-spiritual approaches. She has four research innovations that are registered under MyIPO. Dr. Siti Aishah Hassan has won numerous international and local awards.
