



POSTPONEMENT OF TEACHING PRACTICUM FOR ALL BACHELOR PROGRAMS AT THE FACULTY OF EDUCATIONAL STUDIES AND FACULTY OF SCIENCE, UNIVERSITI PUTRA MALAYSIA IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RESTRICTION OF MOVEMENT ORDER TO CURB THE COVID-19 OUTBREAK

In line with the government's Restricted Movement Order to curb the spread of COVID-19, the Faculty of Educational Studies, Universiti Putra Malaysia will **POSTPONE** teaching practicum for all students throughout the duration of the Restricted Movement Order which is from **18th March** until **14th April 2020**.

Therefore, all students from the Faculty of Educational Studies and the Faculty of Science, who are undergoing teaching practicum, are required to obey the Restricted Movement Order and are **NOT ALLOWED** to go to school for teaching practicum until the restriction ends.

Based on graduation requirements, students have to undergo 12 weeks or 14 weeks (Bachelor of Counselling) of teaching practicum. According to current requirements, students have to replace the days that they are absent from school. However, matters related to replacement days for teaching practicum have not been decided upon. The Faculty of Educational Studies will release a statement regarding this matter at a later date.
