Brief CV PROF DR SAMSILAH ROSLAN S.M.S., RTTP



As an expert in applied psychology, Samsilah Roslan specializes in the application of psychosocial profiling in creating efficient and productive educational, social and work environments. Her work involves identifying factors, developing structural psychosocial profile models for various groups and suggesting the best intervention, programme or blueprint towards enhancement of learners potentials, successful group dynamics and congruent work environment. She has worked with various categories of learners including those with special needs to document their psychosocial profiles and test the efficiency of psychosocial-based interventions to improve learning, behaviour, psychological well-being and socialisation. Her most notable work being the effectiveness of differentiated learning approaches in helping diverse groups of learners attain their educational goals. She has worked with California Association for the Gifted to conduct training for Malaysian teachers on the differentiated learning methodology and Kyushu Institute of Technology to develop and research on the experimental concept of community therapy and fusion lab.

Her expertise on psychosocial profiling was also sought after by FELDA to lead a special project in 2015 on the development of FELDA's blueprint for their new generation of youth. Upon completion of the project, she has been on FELDA's advisory panel for various community transformation programs until now. In 2023, Samsilah is appointed by FELDA to lead a study on the Well-being Index of FELDA settlers in Malaysia. Samsilah was also part of the Psychology Think Tank Committee at the Ministry of Youth and Sports, utilizing her psychosocial profiling expertise to provide the Malaysian Youth Indexes and propose suggestions to policy makers based on this information. In overcoming the threat of radicalism among youth, she was commissioned to conduct a study on the psychosocial profile of ISIS prisoners and develop guidelines for the ministry to curb the spread of this ideology in Malaysia.

Another area where she has implemented psychosocial profiling is in the challenging task of developing university innovations into commercialisable products. Appointed as the Deputy Director and then the Director of Putra Science

Park UPM, between 2009-2019, Samsilah has has led more than 300 negotiations with multinationals, large corporations and SMEs locally and internationally. Realizing that the most common issue is the failure of people from very diverse background and work culture to discuss and work together, she has implemented psychosocial profiling and personality-environment congruence concepts to provide conducive and facilitative platforms for researchers, industries, intellectual property lawyers, venture capitalist and technopreneurs to find common interests and work as a team to develop the technology development blueprint and technology transfer plans and execute them. The creation of congruent teams with positive group dynamics has proven to be effective in helping UPM champion the commercialisation of university innovations. Apart from commercialisation achievements, UPM was named six times winner of national best organization in intellectual property management by MyIPO. Samsilah was also involved in the setting up of Innovation and Technology Managers Association (ITMA) in Malaysia, and is currently the president. She and her team from ITMA have conducted trainings to more than 500 innovation and technology managers from Malaysian public and private universities, polytechnics, as well as other local agencies. She has also conducted international trainings funded by IDB which was attended by participants from various OIC countries.

In 2016, she was appointed as consultant to the Ministry of Education Malaysia on the OIC Collaborative Effort in Commercialization and Entrepreneurship Education (OIC-CECE). She was also appointed by the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI) as the Head of National TechVenture Blueprint for Malaysia (2019), scientific committee member of International Teleconference on Technology and Policy Supporting Implementation of COVID-19 Recovery Plan in Southeast Asia (ITTPsteering committee of Malaysia Social Innovation Accelerator COVID19) 2021, Programme (MySIAP) 2021, member of working group, Human Capital & Research Pillar, Global Innovation Index (2021-2025), Research, Development, Innovation, Commercialisation and Economy (RDICE) Roadmap Study (2022), Malaysia Open Science Platform (MOSP) Policy and Guideline 2021, member, member of Board of Governance (BoG) for Malaysia Laboratories for Academia-Business Collaboration (MyLAB) 2018-2022, Head of the Malaysian team in A Consortium to Conduct A Study on the Development of a National Science and Technology Park at the National University of Science and Technology, Pakistan (2021), Head of the study on Commercialisation Metrics and Enhancement of Technology Transfer Professionals in Malaysian IHLs and GRIs (2023), and Head of the Malaysian Consultants for the University Innovation Hub Management Project under the Hi-Tech Park Authority, of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, funded by World Bank (2023). Samsilah also underwent training in the economics of education and cost analysis programme, Return of Investment (ROI) calculation method by ROI Institute and has conducted several top down ROI research for Ministry of Higher Education Malaysia (MOHE) which were used to develop policies and cabinet papers. She was also the head of the Local Technology Based Industry Sub Group under the Baseline Study for the Science, Technology and Innovation Policy funded by the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI), totaling RM1.5mil.

In addition, Samsilah has also been working on developing Community Therapy through an initiative called Fusion Lab, in collaboration with Kyushu Institute of Technology, Japan. This intervention involves understanding matching psychosocial profiles and using this information in coaching the community (volunteers, university students, gifted students) to interact with autistic, ADHD and Down Syndrome students using the platform of music and theater and staging performances. This program also aims to educate the public on how this synergy can be emulated in everyday life. In addition to significant improvements in social skills and confidence among the students with special needs, participants from the community in this lab reported an increase in the sense of satisfaction and psychological well-being. Samsilah was also involved in the eDU-PARK® programme at UPM, an initiative using experiential learning concepts to portray various learning disciplines at the university to school students and the public in fun and exciting ways. This programme has received interests from local and international visitors since it was launched in 2013. Between 2019 and 2021, Samsilah served as the Dean of Faculty of Educational Studies, UPM.
